

BANK STREET SYMPHONY

This is a unique, **limited edition print** of the Old State Bank, built in 1833, in Decatur, Alabama. In the foreground are members of the Olde Towne Brass, a group that performs in the manner of early American bands. In *Bank Street Symphony*, Doug attempts to take us back to circa 1863, when the nation had divided into bands of brothers to fight a dreadful civil war.

A copy of the print has been framed and matted, and hangs on a brick column in front of the Circulation Desk. About the Artist: Doug Smith was a retired, mechanical engineer and local artist who donated his work each year to the Friends of Decatur Public Library's Pen to Paint Auction. Mr. Smith died on September 23, 2010 at the age of 64.
