

READING ROUND-UP



FAQS

Characters: Must contain the task (from the Game Card) as a CENTRAL character in the book. If the character was deleted from the book would it change the story? If the answer to this question is yes then this book counts for a character task. If removing the character would not change the story then that book does **NOT** work for that character task.

Settings: At least part of the book must be set in the city/location.

Frontier: At least part of the book must be set in an area deemed to be the “limit of civilization or knowledge”.

National Parks: At least part of the book must be set in a National Park (does not have to be in the US-can be any country’s national park.

Saloon/Bar (drinking establishment) at least part of the book must be set in a place designated for the sale and consumption of alcoholic drinks.

Conflict (External and Internal)

Animals –Domestic: The book must contain an animal that has been traditionally kept as a pet or for food.

Animals-Wild: The book must contain a wild animal, can be any wild animal, not just ones found in the Western United States.

Death: The book must contain a death.

Fear: The book must contain fear or invoke that reaction in the reader.

Fever: The book must contain a fever or disease that causes a fever.

Fire: The book must contain a fire.

Greed/Avarice: The book must contain a character that is motivated by greed/avarice.

Hurricane: The book must contain a hurricane.

Isolation: The book must contain a character who is isolated or who feels that way.

Loneliness: The book must contain a character who feels loneliness.

Mountains: The book must contain mountains.

Pride/Arrogance: The book must contain a character who is motivated by pride/arrogance or who is perceived to be that way.

Rain/Floods/Thunderstorms: The book must contain rain, floods, or thunderstorms.

Rivers: The book must contain a river.

Snow/Blizzard/Avalanche: The book must contain snow, a blizzard or an avalanche.

Survival: The book must be about a survival of some kind.

Tornadoes/Wind: The book must contain a tornado or winds.

The other way a book will work for the challenge is if the exact word on the game card is used in the title of the book.

Example: the task is Fever -the book could be *Fever Moon* by Carolyn Haines.
