



GETTING STARTED WITH THE APP

You can use the free OverDrive app to borrow and enjoy digital titles from our library!

The OverDrive app is available for Android™, Chromebook™, iOS® (iPhone /iPad/iPod touch), Kindle Fire® tablets, Kobo® tablets, NOOK® tablets, Windows® 8 and up, and Windows Phone®. OverDrive is also available for Windows and Mac® users.

- 1 On your phone or tablet, **install the OverDrive app** from your device's app store or from app.overdrive.com
- 2 If prompted, **sign into the OverDrive app** with a free OverDrive account.
- 3 **Find and save our library's OverDrive collection** in the OverDrive app.
- 4 Open our library's OverDrive collection, **sign in, and borrow or place a hold on a title**. You'll need a valid library card to complete this step.
- 5 Borrowed titles will appear on your Checkouts page on the library's OverDrive website. From here, you can:
 - Download titles to the Bookshelf in the OverDrive app
 - Read, Watch, or Listen to titles right in your browser (without adding them to the app)
 - Send Kindle Books (U.S. only) to your Kindle device or Kindle reading app

GETTING STARTED WITH A COMPUTER

Use these steps to borrow and enjoy digital titles from your library on your Windows® or Mac® computer.

NOTE: If you're using a Chromebook™ or Windows 8 and up, you can use the OverDrive app to borrow and enjoy digital titles from your library. See "Getting started with the app" for more help.

- 1 Go to your library's OverDrive website: camellia.overdrive.com/
- 2 Sign into your library's OverDrive website and borrow a title. You'll need a valid library card to complete this step.
- 3 Borrowed titles will appear on your Checkouts page on your library's OverDrive website. From here, you can:
 - Read, watch, or listen to titles right in your browser
 - Download eBooks, then read them using free Adobe Digital Editions software or transfer them to supported eReaders
 - Download audiobooks, then listen to them using OverDrive's free desktop app for Windows or Mac or transfer them to supported MP3 players
 - Send Kindle Books (U.S. only) to your Kindle device or Kindle reading app
